Subject: Budget Transfer

The Restoration Budget does not have enough funds available to pay the November and December invoices that were received from the Restoration Contractor. The Restoration Budget is based on historical averages and 2018's restoration costs have exceeded what was budgeted by approximately 9%. There are excess funds available in Unit 2502 (Payments to Contractors – Tanks) that can be used to supplement the restoration budget.

The Engineering Department is therefore requesting a budget transfer in the amount of \$200,000 from Unit 2502 Line Item 74 Payments to Contractors – Tanks to Unit 2535 Line Item 18 Payments to Contractors – Restoration.
