Under the provisions of the New York Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, I hereby request records or portions thereof pertaining to (or containing the following):

*Proposal / previous request to install 5g Vertical Bridge (Verizon Wireless) telecommunication tower on or near the water tank / tower located at or near the corner of 20A (Quaker Road) and Transit Road (possibly 4155 Transit Road, Orchard Park, NY 14127). The current proposed tower location is: 4399 Transit Road, Orchard Park, NY 14127 and will be impeding the public's view if it is allowed. I would like to know, if possible, why their request (if there was one) to locate the tower on land with a public utility was denied.*
