

On 2/6/23 at approximately 1545, traffic was diverted at the junction of Millersport Highway and Campbell Boulevard (2600 Millersport Highway), due to road work being done. On 2/7/23 the diversion was no longer in place, and the barriers were removed. On my way to work at about 0600, I entered Millersport Highway from Campbell Boulevard, I noticed there was debris across the road. I went through the traffic light and soon after I heard a clicking noise, I pulled over and looked and did not see anything unusual (it was dark due to the time of day), and there was no indication on the car's dashboard. As I continued my journey to work along Millersport Highway the tire indicator light came on, suggesting that the driver's rear tire needed air. I made it to work and called Land Rover service, and a technician was dispatched. The technician took the flat tire off and put the donut 'tire' on, there was a large object in the tire. The flat tire was later taken to Land Rover service, and the technician there indicated that the hole caused by the object was too large to patch, so a new tire was ordered and replaced.
