The nature of the claim is an action for the recovery of property damage to Claimant's underground facilities, for gas loss, and for the cost of the repair of said underground facilities caused solely by the negligence of Defendant and Defendant's violation of the law of trespass, General Business Law, <u>inter alia</u>, Article 36, Sections 760 – 765; Public Service Law, <u>inter alia</u>, Section 119-b; 16 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 753; 29 C.F.R. Sections 1926.1, <u>et. seq.</u>, while Defendant was excavating in the Village of Blasdell, County of Erie and State of New York.

3. The time when, the place where and the manner in which the incidents underlying the claim arose are as follows:

(i) Damage to Claimant's underground facilities occurred on May 29, 2025, at approximately 5:55 p.m., at or near 70 Maple Avenue, Town of Blasdell, County of Erie and State of New York, when the Defendant was excavating, Defendant negligently and in violation of the law of trespass, General Business Law, <u>inter alia</u>, Article 36, Sections 760 – 765; Public Service Law, <u>inter alia</u>, Section 119-b; 16 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 753; 29 C.F.R. Sections 926.1, <u>et. seq.</u>, hit and caused damage to Claimant's natural gas line and the loss of gas.

4. The items of damage are property damage to Claimant's underground facilities, detailed above, and the cost of repairing said damage. That said claim and demand is hereby presented for adjustment and payment. PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that by reason of the foregoing, and upon the default of the Erie County Water Authority, to pay Claimant the full amount of the damages suffered by reason of the foregoing, within the time limited for compliance with this demand by the said Erie County Water Authority, by the statutes in such cases made and provided, Claimant will institute an action against the Erie County Water Authority, to recover the full amount of Claimant's damages, with interest and costs.

To Whom It May Concern:

For both contractors and homeowners, having underground utilities marked prior to starting excavation or an outdoor project is essential for protecting yourself from injury and preventing damage to underground utility lines. New York state law (16 NYRCC Part 753) requires you to place a location request ("One Call ticket") with UDIG•NY prior to beginning any work to ensure all underground utility lines are properly marked. Recently you struck and damaged a main line in front of the property located at 70 Maple Avenue, Blasdell, New York. This released a large amount of natural gas, which endangered the lives and properties of nearby homeowners, pedestrians, emergency personnel, National Fuel employees, and you. There was no UDIG•NY One Call ticket placed prior to your excavation. New York State law requires all excavators and homeowners to adhere to the following rules, among other things:

- Contact UDIG•NY not less than 2 (not counting the day you call) but no more than 10 working days prior to excavation or demolition work.
- Each company, excavator, or homeowner **MUST** have their own UDIG•NY One Call ticket. You may not excavate an area based on a previous company's/excavator's/homeowner's one call ticket markings.
- Use the color **white** (paint, flags or stakes) to mark the proposed excavation area when the exact site information cannot be provided. This will pinpoint the area to eliminate unnecessary spotting.
- Before beginning excavation, check responses from all notified utilities on the ticket request to confirm each utility has either marked your work site or given an "all clear" indicating there are no facilities in your work area.
- Properly maintain the staking and marking throughout excavation.
- Maintain a tolerance zone of 2' (24" on both sides plus width of the facility). Use hand dug test holes to expose and verify the location of the line before excavation equipment is used.

Any person found in violation of these provisions may be billed for damages incurred by National Fuel. Additionally, the New York State Public Service Commission could also fine the responsible party. Excavating without having all the surrounding utilities marked can create a dangerous situation and pose a threat to you, your crew, the public and our utility lines. Please call UDIG•NY prior to future excavations to avoid these issues. Calling UDIG•NY for a utility mark out is free and at no cost to the caller, excavator, or homeowner. If you wish to learn more about the New York State law or the free service provided by UDIG•NY, please visit their website, www.UDIGNY.org.
