Claimant's Statement (please print legibly and be specific):

I am the property owner at 228 Highland Ave in the City of Tonawanda. Damage was done to my bubbler system on 5/4/2026 by the company contracted by the Erie County Water Authority to remove and replace two concrete squares in the sidewalk in front of my home. The company arrived at my home before I left for work at approximately 8:30 am. Upon returning home from work, I saw the top to the bubbler tee laying in the grass next to a broken piece of PVC pipe from the bubbler. I received no communication from the company contracted by the Erie County Water Authority, or from the Erie County Water Authority itself, informing me of the damage to my property. The bubbler tee is broken below the soil line so it needs to be replaced. Please see the included photos of damage and estimate for repair from REC Plumbing.

I first contacted the Erie County Water Authority on 5/7/2026 to report the damage to my bubbler system by their contracted company. I was transferred to the Claims Department and I left a voicemail. I have been in communication with Molly from Claims numerous times via telephone, voicemail, text and email beginning on 5/7/2026 through 6/26/2026 when I received the Notice of Claim Form by email.

As of today, no resolution has been offered.

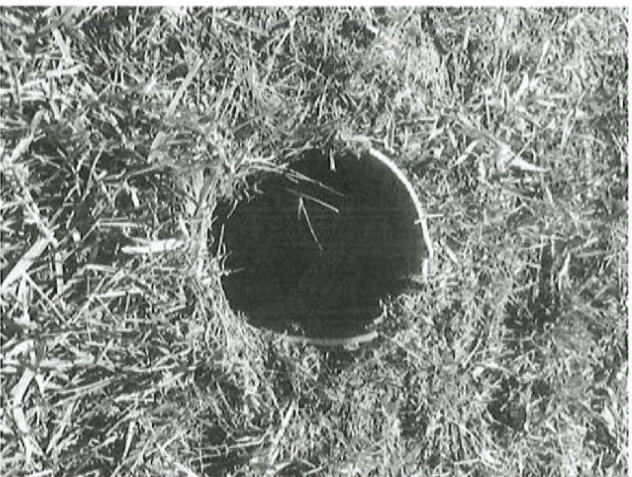
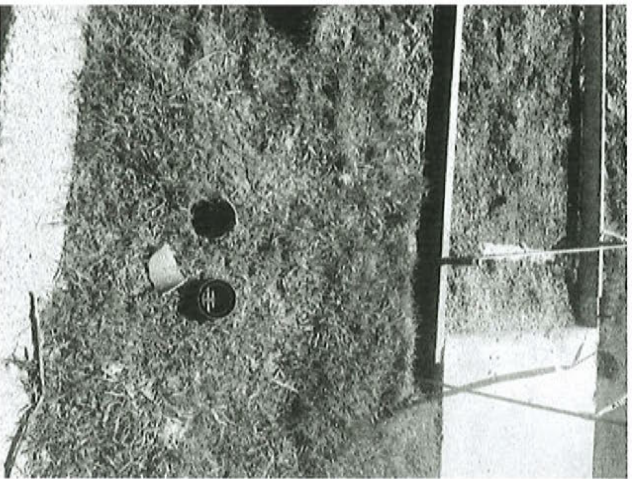
