**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE,** that the undersigned hereby makes this notice of claim in compliance with the applicable statutes of the State of New York:

- The Claimants herein are Gloria Shinners and Robert Shinners who reside at 3191
   Winsted Road, Hamburg, NY 14075.
- The Claimants herein are represented by law firm of Collins & Collins Attorneys,
   LLC, 267 North Street, Buffalo, NY 14201.
- 3. The subject claim is for personal injuries and associated medical and economic loss sustained by reason of the negligence and statutory violations of the respondent, Erie County Water Authority, by and through its agents, servants and/or employees.
- 5. Upon information and belief, on or before June 26, 2025, Erie County Water Authority, by and through its agents, servants, and/or employees, were performing construction and/or maintenance work at the intersection of Winsted Road and Stratford Terrace in Hamburg New York, 14075. During this construction and/or maintenance work, Erie County Water

Authority, by and through its agents, servants, and/or employees, created a hazardous condition at the intersection.

- 4. The incident giving rise to the damages occurred on June 26, 2025, at approximately 9:15 A.M., when the Claimant, Gloria Shinners, tripped and fell on a defect and/or hazardous condition located at the intersection of Winsted Road and Stratford Terrace in Hamburg New York, 14075. At the time of the incident, there was no work being actively performed. Shortly after, Erie County Water Authority, by and through its agents, servants, and/or employees, filled the hazardous condition. Attached hereto and made a part hereof as **Exhibit A** are photographs of the hazardous condition after it was filled. As a result of the fall, the claimant suffered serious and permanent injuries including but not limited to her foot.
- 5. The aforesaid incident was caused by the negligence and statutory violations of the respondent, Erie County Water Authority, by and through its agents, servants and/or employees. The negligence of the respondent includes, but is not limited to, failure to maintain its premises in a reasonably safe condition for users, failing to place any warning signs, failing to place any barricades, particularly in the area depicted in the photographs described above.
- 6. As a result of the negligence of the respondent, Erie County Water Authority, Claimant, Gloria Shinners, has sustained serious and permanent injuries along with medical expenses.
- 7. At the time of the incident, Claimant, Robert Shinners, was married to Claimant, Gloria Shinners. Claimant, Robert Shinners, seeks damages including but not limited to: loss of consortium; loss of support; and interference with the martial relationship.

8. The total sum claimed is in an amount to be determined by a jury and it shall include past and future pain and suffering, past and future lost wages, and past and future medical expenses.
