On December 29, 2022 a neighbor called the homeowner, Cheryl Flick after another neighbor said that we had flooding on our lawn and in the street in front of our house, 77 Leni Lane, Cheektowaga, NY 14225. They called the water authority because neither Dan or Cheryl Flick were home. The water authority showed up at our residence and told our neighbor that we had a break between the house and sidewalk. Dan got home from work and they stated the same thing to him and that we had to call a plumber. The WA shut off the water at the street and we left our residence for the day and night. The next day Rice Plumbing was at our residence, 12/30/22, at 7 am with workers and several trucks with equipment. They started to do diagnostic testing to determine where the break was. They could not find a problem and told Dan Flick this. They called the water authority back to the residence. The WA assured them there was a break despite the plumbing company being able to find one. The plumbers asked the WA if anyone has home using water when they did their testing and they responded, "they didn't know." At the time they were first here on 12/29/22 our teenage son was home. The WA left again and Rice Plumbing came into the house for testing and to check water pressure. They could not find anything wrong and said everything was fine on their end. They left because they could not find a problem and did want to wrongfully dig and incur a charge we didn't need. We have not had any water problems in or outside of our home.


On 12/29/22 it was a warm day, in the 50's I believe, and snow was melting from a blizzard we had the week before. They said that possibly our son was using the bathroom or showering during their testing or the washing machine was on and they never bothered to properly check.

We then received a bill from Rice Plumbing in the amount of \$1650.00. We feel that it is not right that we have to pay these charges since there was not a break at our residence despite two employees of the water authority stating there was.
