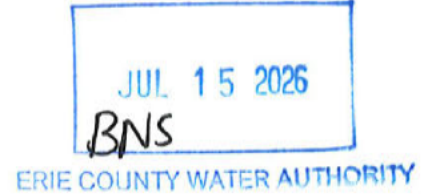

Erie County Water Authority (ECWA) came to install a water meter and to connect public water at the street at our new build at 611 Maple Road. In the process, ECWA tore up a portion of the sidewalk and patched it up with blacktop. In order to receive our Certificate of Occupancy from the Town of Amherst we had to have all damaged sidewalks fully replaced. Because more than just the sections damaged by ECWA needed to be replaced, we hired an outside contractor to do so. The outside contractor was informed that ECWA was responsible for those patched with blacktop but they replaced the whole section at once due to the time constraints we had with the certificate of occupancy. We are seeking reimbursement for the portion that was damaged by ECWA and that they were responsible for.

All statements herein are made under penalty of perjury.

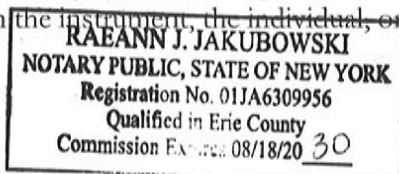

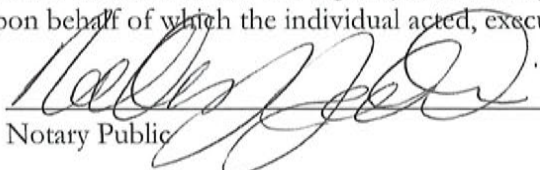

We will pitch new concrete toward the street or grass area and take an extra step in rolling concrete with a steel roller to embed the aggregate into the concrete mix. This helps reduce pitting of the surface.
