It was suggested that I install a new water meter. I agreed and on the day of the installation the installer removed the old (self report) meter and in the process of installing the new meter had the first two attempts fail due to defective leaking meters. In the process the installer had to drain the system multiple times. I noticed water on the floor and assumed that the installer had spilled on his was to my utility sink. I cleaned up the water. Later that day I noticed a similar puddle of water in the same place(near my furnace feed line).

Upon inspection I saw that the pressure release line was dripping, Note that in the four plus years that the furnace has been in place there has never been a drip or release of water.

I called Capital Heat, who installed the new furnace (I can supply copy of the invoice). Capital came and inspected the system and I was told the fix was to replace the pressure regulator valve. When asked if the two defective water meters could have caused this leakage - he couldn't definitively say but it was unusual for the pressure regulator valve to leak.

I request that the Erie County Water Authority compensate me for the replacement of the damaged pressure relief valve.
