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
Claimant's Statement (please print legibly and be specific):

Some years ago, men who stated they were checking for lead supply lines dug up the front yards of the houses in my neighborhood. They dug a large hole adjacent to the water supply curb box and sewer riser on my property. During work, several men got in the hole, checked the line and later backfilled the hole. The soil subsequently sunk in that area and remains significantly lower than the surrounding lawn. They also added a thin PVC collar to the top of the sewer riser, above the elbow. This riser was previously above the soil level, but had sunk at least one to two feet when they dug. Since then, we have been experiencing slow drains. The past several years, we've had water backing up into our basement, which had never occurred before and has worsened each year. We finally had a plumber out to diagnose the problem this spring. They ran a camera and cabled the line and discovered a collapsed pipe and clay in the line directly below where the workmen had dug and were standing in the hole. The plumber stated that it was clear they had collapsed the pipe when they dug/were in the hole as it was directly below their work area and as evidenced by their need to add the PVC collar to the sewer riser, which was previously above soil level. Three of my neighbors, directly on both sides of my property, have also had subsequent sewer issues and, in two cases, had line repair for collapsed pipes. The plumber supplied a repair estimate, which is attached to this claim form.

All statements herein are made under penalty of perjury.


