The Authority contracts with a diving contractor to perform underwater diving services for various work, including the following:

- Buoy installation (Spring) and removal (Fall) for the Van de Water Treatment Plant intake.
- Inspection, cleaning, and condition assessment of the raw water facilities at each treatment plant including the intake crib, tunnel, screens, and wet well structures.
- Inspection, and condition assessment of finished water structures including the clearwells at each treatment plant.

The above referenced contract to provide these services will expire on October 31, 2025. The Authority and the Contractor, Hohl Industrial Services, Inc., agree that a one-year extension of the current contract at the same terms and conditions would be mutually beneficial for both parties. The Contractor expressed interest in extending the current contract in the attached letter dated August 21, 2025.

Amendment No. 1 will extend the contract completion date to October 31, 2026. The Engineering Department recommends the contract extension described above for the Board's consideration and, if approved, for the Chairman to execute.

AMENDMENT, effective September 18, 2025, to the Agreement for Buoy Installation and Underwater Services (Contract No. 24-18-10) (the "Agreement"), entered on October 17, 2024, by and between

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2024, the Authority awarded the Contractor the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the Contractor will furnish buoy installation and underwater services to the Authority from November 1, 2024 to October 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 1, Section 1.05 of the Agreement, the parties may agree in writing to extend this Agreement under the same terms and conditions, or upon such terms and conditions acceptable to the Authority, for two (2) additional one (1) year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has agreed to extend this Agreement until October 31, 2026 based on the same terms and conditions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises herein set forth, the parties agree to the following:

- (1) The terms and conditions of the Agreement shall continue in effect until October 31, 2026; and
- (2) The parties agree all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in effect; and
- (3) This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which together are deemed to be one and the same agreement.
