The Erie County Water Authority utilizes polyaluminum chloride coagulant chemical to treat the water produced at the Sturgeon Point and Van de Water Treatment Plants. The use of polyaluminum chlorine is a critical component of the pretreatment process and aids in the removal of turbidity and organic material from the raw water.

The above referenced contract to furnish and deliver polyaluminum chloride will expire on June 30, 2021. This unit price contract was initially bid for two years with the provision for a one-year extension.
