The Erie County Water Authority utilizes labor, equipment, and materials provided by a private contractor for the painting, and coating of various system components including pipe, tanks, and pumps. Services performed to support the new painting and coatings include sand/grit blasting, pit filling, tank cleaning and disinfection, and environmental controls such as dust collection, ventilation, heating, and dehumidification. Labor provided by the contractor includes welders, painters, and general laborers, both in the field and at the contractor's shop.

The above referenced contract to furnish labor, equipment, and materials related to the above described work will expire on March 31, 2021. This contract was initially bid for one year with the provision for a one-year extension. The original contract was executed on July 16, 2020, of which, \$148,512.41 (78.1%) of the \$190,206.00 contract value remains.

The Authority and the contractor, Niagara Coatings Services, Inc., agree that a one-year extension of the current contract to March 31, 2022 at the same terms and conditions would be mutually beneficial for both parties. The Contractor's interest in extending the current contract is expressed in the attached letter received February 1, 2021.

Niagara Coatings Services has proven to be a highly capable and reliable contractor whose services are valuable in the operation of Authority facilities. Based on this information it is recommended that the Authority exercise the one-year extension.

10.03 Successors and Assigns

A. OWNER and CONTRACTOR each binds itself, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives to the other party hereto, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives in respect to all covenants, agreements and obligations contained in the Contract Documents.

10.04 Severability

A. Any provision or part of the Contract Document, held to be void or unenforceable under any Law or Regulation shall be deemed stricken, and all remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and binding upon OWNER and CONTRACTOR, who agree that the Contract Documents shall be reformed to replace such stricken provision or part thereof with a valid and enforceable provision that comes as close as possible to expressing the intention of the stricken provision.

10.05 Waiver

A. The waiver by the OWNER of any breach or violation of any term, covenant, or condition of this Agreement or of any Law or Regulation shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any other term, covenant, condition, or Law or Regulation or of any subsequent breach or violation of the same or of any other term, covenant, condition, or Law or Regulation. The subsequent payment of any monies or fee by the OWNER which may become due hereunder shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any preceding breach or violation by CONTRACTOR of any term, covenant, condition of this Agreement or of any applicable Law or Regulation.

11.00 GROUNDS FOR RENEWAL OF CONTRACT

A. If the Erie County Water Authority and CONTRACTOR mutually agree to continue this Contract after the 31st day of March 2021, it shall be extended for the term of one (1) year on the same terms and conditions provided for herein. CONTRACTOR shall provide written notification to the Erie County Water Authority of the contract extension prior to the expiration of the initial term of this Contract.

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 00500, paragraph 11.00, subparagraph A of the Contract, the parties may agree to extend the Contract on the same terms and conditions for one year; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has agreed to extend this Contract until March 31, 2022 based on the same terms and conditions, including but not limited to, labor billed at an hourly rate, at the service rates set forth in section 00410, paragraph 5.01, Item 1 of the Contract; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises herein set forth, the parties agree to the following:

- (1) The terms and conditions of the Contract shall continue in effect until March 31, 2022;
- (2) This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which together are deemed to be one and the same agreement; and

(3) The parties agree to accept electronic signature pages, signed in conformity with the Governor's Executive Order No. 202.8, allowing any notarial action to be performed utilizing audio-video technology.
