Subject: Authorization for General Counsel to Approve Claim Payments

In November 1999, the Board of Commissioners passed a resolution permitting General Counsel to approve certain settlements (the "1999 Resolution"). Recently, the Authority's deductible on its insurance policies with Munich RE increased from \$15,000 to \$25,000. Accordingly, it would seem appropriate to amend General Counsel's authority for settlement purposes.

The 1999 Resolution authorized General Counsel to accept settlements in claims where the Authority was the injured party. The 1999 Resolution did not contemplate or account for situations where notices of claims were filed against the prior to the commencement of an action. A copy of the 1999 Resolution is attached for your review.

Since the appointment of Ms. Musarra as Claims Representative/Risk Manager, all notices of claims are being investigated internally and reviewed thoroughly in order to make an initial determination of whether it is in the best interests of the Authority to resolve the claim internally or to put our insurance carriers on notice and have the claims handled externally by our carriers. Over the past several years, this has saved the Authority thousands of dollars as prior insurance adjusters were willing to resolve claims at or just minimally above our claim deductible limits without input from either General Counsel or our Claims Representative.

In order to further streamline this process of internal claim resolution, I am recommending that the Board authorize General Counsel to approve any and all claims under \$25,000.00. All such recommended settlement amounts will be sent from the General Counsel to the Secretary, Chief Financial Officer, and Comptroller for approval. By making such authorization, the Board will expedite the handling of notices of claims and will permit the Authority to have greater ability to retain control over claims which can be resolved below our \$25,000 insurance deductible.

A resolution has been included for your consideration at the Board meeting of September 18, 2025. Additionally, an updated resolution will be sent to the Board at all upcoming Annual meetings.

Fuzak, Associate Counsel recommends that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Legal Department to settle any claims in which the Authority is the Plaintiff for amounts up to \$5,000.00 less than the original claim amount; and

ITEM 13 - AUTHORIZATION OF DIRECTIONS TO HSBC BANK USA, AS TRUSTEE UNDER THE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION REVENUE BOND RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, HSBC Bank USA (the "Trustee") serves as Trustee under the General Improvement and Extension Revenue Bond Resolution (the "1973 Bond Resolution") adopted by the Erie County Water Authority (the "Authority") on December 11, 1973; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Sections 402(4) and 407 of the 1973 Bond Resolution, the Trustee holds the Debt Reserve Fund, as defined in the 1973 Bond Resolution, with respect to Bonds issued thereunder; and

WHEREAS, The Authority and the Trustee entered into the 1973 Bonds Escrow Deposit Agreement (the "Escrow Agreement") as of April 1, 1990, which provided, among other things, for the purchase of a Treasury Note maturing on November 15, 1999 in the par amount of \$2,955,000 (the "Treasury Note"), to be deposited in the Debt Reserve Fund; and

WHEREAS, Sections 3(e) and 5 of the Escrow Agreement provide for principal and interest on the obligations described in the Escrow Agreement, including the Treasury Note, to be used to pay outstanding bonds issued under the 1973 Bond Resolution, in accordance with the 1973 Bond Resolution ("1973 Bonds"); and
