- Authorization Form requesting Board Authorization to execute the attached Amendment No. 1 to Professional Service Agreement with William Schutt and Associates (Schutt).
- Amendment No. 1 to Professional Service Agreement for the above-referenced project.

On February 13, 2020, the Authority and Wm. Schutt & Associates (Schutt) entered into a professional services contract for design and construction phase services for the above-referenced project. This project, for which construction is nearing completion included the replacement of various watermains in the City of Lackawanna and the Town of Hamburg. A portion of the project required access across a Norfolk and Southern Railroad right-of-way including the construction of a temporary rail crossing constructed by the railroad. The project was scheduled to be completed on July 29, 2022. The project experienced significant delays during construction due to railroad access issues including the premature removal of the rail crossing.

As a result, Schutt has incurred additional engineering fees for construction administration services and will incur additional costs for record drawing preparation as follows:

The additional fee requested by Schutt to complete the work is \$43,680.00. However, since the project is nearing completion, there are remaining funds in the Special Services item available to offset some of the additional costs resulting in a total increase in the contract of \$13,680.00. ECWA and the Consultant discussed the level of services that were required and associated additional fees, the Engineering Department believes that additional fees being requested are reasonable based on the overall duration of construction.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

AMENDMENT, effective July 23, 2025 ("Amendment No. 1"), to the Professional Services Agreement, effective on February 13, 2020, by and between

ERIE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY

hereinafter referred to as the "Authority," and

WM. SCHUTT & ASSOCIATES

37 Central Avenue Lancaster, New York 14086

hereinafter referred to as the "Consultant."

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2020, the Authority awarded the Consultant a professional services contract to provide engineering and consulting services relating to upgrades to the distribution waterlines in the City of Lackawanna and Town of Hamburg (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, construction delays related to access issues caused by railroad lines have resulted in a need for additional general services and record drawings from the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Operating Officer and Executive Engineer recommend that the Authority amend the Contract to increase the Consultant's fee by \$13,680.00; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 5 of the Contract, any modification or variation from the terms of the Contract, must be in writing, authorized by a resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Authority (the "Board"), and signed by all parties to be effective;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises herein set forth, the parties agree to the following:

- The parties agree to amend Article 3, Paragraph (D)(1) to increase the lump sum for General Services by \$40,350.00, changing the current figure of \$53,300.00 to \$93,650.00; and
- (2) The parties agree to amend Article 3, Paragraph (D)(1) to increase the lump sum for Record Drawings by \$3,330.00, changing the current figure of \$23,500.00 to \$26,830.00; and

- (3) The parties agree to amend Article 3, Paragraph (B) to decrease the total not to exceed for Special Services by \$30,000.00, changing the current figure of \$50,000.00 to \$20,000.00; and
- (4) The parties agree all other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain without change or amendment; and
- (5) This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which is deemed an original, but all of which together are deemed to be one and the same agreement.

IN WITNESS WHERETO, the parties hereto have caused this Amendment No. 1 to be signed by their respective duly constituted officers, attested and sealed pursuant to proper authority.
