Subject: Carden Avenue Paving City of Lackawanna Cooperative Agreement Contract GP-010 ECWA Project No. 202100035

As a part of Authority's Contract GP-010 (PN 202100035) the City of Lackawanna (City) requested that the Authority complete milling and paving of Carden Avenue as part of the project.

The project originally included the replacement of the existing mains on Abbott Road with an interconnection to the existing main on Carden Avenue. The interconnection was to be completed roughly at the intersection of Abbott and Carden however the condition of the main on Carden was such that replacement was warranted. The replacement of the main included trench restoration. Following completion of the new main, the City determined that it would be in the best interest of the residents as well as to improve access to a City school building to mill and pave the full width of the street.

The ECWA Engineering Department developed quantity take-offs and cost estimate, utilizing the bid items from the executed contract with E&R General Construction. Inclusion of this work with the Authority's project will recognize an economy of scales versus the City paving the street on its own. Using the estimated quantities and the unit price bid, the estimated cost of the work is \$12,000.00. The City will be invoiced for the actual amount determined by actual in place quantities following completion of the work.

A Cooperative Agreement (Agreement) was developed by the Legal and Engineering Departments and presented to the City and the Contractor. The City and the contractor have reviewed the terms of the Agreement and the City will approve and execute the Agreement following their October 10th Council meeting.

Attached find three copies of the Agreement for review and approval by the Board. Once executed by the City, the Contractor and the Authority Chairman one copy each must be returned to the City and Contractor.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

This Cooperative Agreement ("Agreement"), effective as of October 19, 2023 ("Effective Date"), is by and among

ERIE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY

hereinafter referred to as the "Authority" and

CITY OF LACKAWANNA

714 Ridge Road Lackawanna, New York 14218

hereinafter referred to as the "City" and

E. & R. GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, INC.

38 **St**. David's Drive West Seneca, New York 14224

Hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor."

WHEREAS, the Authority has initiated a capital improvement project, known as the Transmission and Distribution Main Replacement, Towns of West Seneca and Hamburg and the City of Lackawanna (Contract GP-010) generally consisting of the replacement of the existing watermains on Willett and Abbott Roads (the "Main Replacement Project"), and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2022, the Authority awarded a construction contract to the Contractor to complete the Main Replacement Project (the "Main Replacement Project Contract"), and

WHEREAS, the Main Replacement Project includes the replacement of an existing watermain on Carden Avenue in the City of Lackawanna with restoration to the trench width of the road only, and

WHEREAS, the City has requested that the Authority consider milling and paving the entire width of Carden Avenue from Abbott Road west approximately 250 linear feet to the property line of the Lackawanna Middle and High Schools as part of the Main Replacement Project, and

WHEREAS, the Main Replacement Project Contract includes milling and paving of Willett and Abbott Roads and includes unit prices for this work, and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has agreed to perform milling and paving work on Carden Avenue at the unit prices set forth in the Main Replacement Project Contract, and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed the unit prices for milling and paving work as set forth in the Main Replacement Project Contract and agrees they are fair and reasonable, and

WHEREAS, by working in a cooperative fashion to resurface Carden Avenue as part of the Authority's Project, both the City and the Authority will save money and limit the disturbance to the residents of Carden Avenue, as well as the students and staff at the Lackawanna Middle and High Schools,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 CARDEN AVENUE MILLING AND PAVING

1.01 All of the recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into the body of this Agreement as though separately and specifically set forth herein.

1.02 The limits of the milling and paving requested by the City will be as shown on Exhibit A, which is attached to and incorporated in this Agreement, and generally includes the entire width of Carden Avenue between Abbott Road and the property line of the Lackawanna Middle and High Schools (the "Carden Avenue Paving").

1.03 The Authority agrees to complete the final milling and paving of Carden Avenue, through its Contractor as part of the Main Replacement Project.

1.04 During construction, the Authority will perform resident inspection services and will immediately notify the City, or its designated project engineer, of any associated problems with the Carden Avenue Paving.

ARTICLE 2 COSTS

2.01 The City and the Authority have agreed that the Authority will pay for the construction of the Main Replacement Project per the unit prices established in the Main Replacement Project Contract, excluding the costs of the Carden Avenue Paving. The Authority and the City agree the estimated costs for the Carden Avenue Paving are approximately $\frac{12,000.00}{0}$.

2.02 The Contractor agrees to complete the Carden Avenue Milling and Paving under Item 11B6 – For Cold Milling and Placement of Asphalt Top Course (1-1/2) thickness) at a unit price of <u>\$19.00</u> per square yard as set forth in the Main Replacement Project Contract with the Authority.

2.03 The City has agreed to pay for all costs associated with the Carden Avenue Paving.

2.04 The City has agreed to reimburse the Authority for all costs associated with the Carden Avenue Paving based upon the final quantity of area milled and paved.

ARTICLE 3

ACCEPTANCE OF THE CARDEN AVENUE PAVING BY THE CITY

3.01 At the completion of all the Main Replacement Project and after all the conditions set forth above are complied with to the satisfaction of the Authority and the City, the City agrees to accept said project as complete.

ARTICLE 4 GENERAL PROVISIONS

4.01 <u>Independent Status</u>: Nothing contained in the agreement shall be constructed to render either the Authority or the City, employee, or agent of the other, nor shall either party have authority to bind the other in any matter, other than set forth in this agreement. It is intended that each party shall remain independent and separate from the other, and fully responsible for its own actions.

4.02 *Indemnification*

- A. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the City agrees to indemnify and hold the Authority harmless from all third party claims, liabilities, damages and costs (including all reasonable attorney's fees, and cost of defense) to which the Authority, its officers, directors, employees and agents may be subject to, arising out of the death or bodily injury to any person or the destruction or damage to any property to the extent caused by the negligent acts, errors or omissions, or willful misconduct of the City, its officers, directors, employees and agents under this Agreement and those of its contractors or subcontractors or anyone for whom the Town is legally liable.
- B. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Authority agrees to indemnify and hold the City harmless from all third-party claims, liabilities, damages, and costs (including all reasonable attorney's fees and cost of defense) to the extent caused by the negligent acts, errors or omissions of the Authority, its contractors, engineers, or anyone for whom the Authority is legally liable.

4.03 <u>Amendments and Modifications</u>: No modification, amendment or changes in the Carden Avenue Paving shall be valid unless the Authority is given prior written notice by the City and/or the Contractor and the Authority gives the City and the Contractor prior written approval of same.

4.04 *Notice*: Any notices required by this Agreement or otherwise shall be delivered by United States Postal mail or personal delivery upon the addresses stated above. Any change in

such addresses shall be required to be in writing to the other party and acknowledged as such.

4.05 <u>New York Law and Jurisdiction</u>: Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, any dispute concerning any question of fact or law arising under this Agreement which is not disposed of by agreement between the parties shall be governed, interpreted and decided by a court of competent jurisdiction of the State of New York in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.

4.06 <u>Entire Agreement</u>: This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between the parties relating to its subject matter. All prior or contemporaneous contracts, understandings and statements are merged herein.

4.07 <u>Approval</u>: This Agreement is subject to approval by the respective parties in accordance with the authority granted to each party.



- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance for the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the Site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions as provided in paragraph 4.02 of the General Conditions, and (2) reports and drawings of a Hazardous Environmental Condition identified at the Site, if any, which have been identified in the Supplementary 4.06 of the General Conditions.
