The main reason why we were unable to meet our goal of 10% WMBE was that we did not have to buy as much concrete as we had originally thought based on the units in the original bid package. The percentage of units that utilize concrete in the original bid was higher than what was used during the life of the contract. And the purchase of concrete was by far largest single material used on this contract. We bought every yard of concrete utilized on this contract from the minority supplier per the contract. We also used this supplier for other Ledge Creek projects as well. So, we were trying there just was not very much material or sub-contracting used on this project. By far the largest cost was our own labor.
