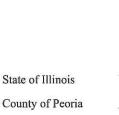

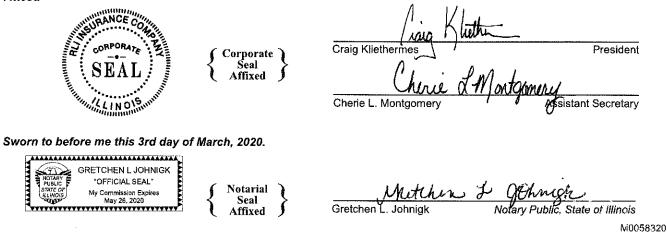

In completing the Minority Business Enterprise Utilization Report -Part D, our 13.1% goal was not realized. Our goal quantity was based on our bid which was compiled from the Engineer's estimated quantities. We understand that the Engineer's quantities are not guaranteed, but rather used for comparison of bids; however it is the only data that we have pre-bid to estimate our WMBE utilization. Below are explanations for concrete and trucking.

#### Concrete

- Items 11A1, 11A2, 11A3 & 11A4 Concrete Driveway & Sidewalk Restoration, Base Course & Curb
  - Bid quantity for items 11A1 & 11A2 was 1,000 SY. The actual amount installed was 502.79 SY (50%)
  - Bid quantity for 11A3 was 50 SY. The actual amount installed was 17.81 SY. (35.6%)
  - Bid quantity for 11A4 was 375 LF. The actual amount installed was 21.2 LF (5.7%)
- Item 13C Extra Concrete Bid quantity was 50 CY. No extra concrete was utilized on the job. (0%)

#### Trucking

- Item 6A Select Fill
  - o Bid quantity for item 6A was 4,300 CY. The actual amount installed in the job was 3,549 CY (82.5%)
- Item 1A3 8" Ductile Iron Pipe
  - Pipe was installed at a rate faster than it was bid. The actual days were 22.9% less than plan. The actual hours to haul spoil away were 24.9% less than plan.
  - Provisions in the PPP loan required head count to be maintained. Our internal trucking hours were 16.2% higher than prior year and 100% higher than planned.

Lavonya – I remember discussing this with you a couple months ago.

Their statement about the concrete quantities is accurate, the actual quantities utilized on the project were less than what was estimated, therefore reducing their ability to utilize an MWBE subcontractor for this work.

For the trucking, they basically finished the work faster than they thought they would and therefore didn't utilize their MWBE trucking subcontractor as much as they originally anticipated.

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
