SEQR Lead Agency Coordination ECWA Project No. 202000084

On December 22, 2021, the Erie County Water Authority (the "Authority") executed an agreement with GHD Consulting Service, INC. (GHD) for the design of a new 48-inch diameter transmission main from the Colvin Tank located off Colvin Boulevard/Twin City Highway and the I-290/I-990 Interchange in the Town of Tonawanda (approximate length of 18,500 LF). The new transmission main will "parallel" the existing 48-inch transmission main in that area, adding a redundant pipe to the distribution system.

During the preliminary design, it was determined that this project is a Type 1 action and a coordinated review is required pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR). GHD recommended that the Authority declare itself lead agency and conduct a coordinated review using the Part I of the Full EAF. GHD also recommended the following involved agencies be included in the coordinated review:

- 1. Town of Tonawanda Engineering Department
- 2. City of Tonawanda Engineering Department
- 3. Town of Amherst Engineering Department
- 4. Erie County Health Department
- 5. New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation
- 6. United States Army Corps of Engineers
- 7. New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation
- 8. National Grid
- 9. New York State Department of Environmental Conservation
- 10. New York State Department of Transportation
- 11. New York State Office of General Services
- 12. Erie County Department of Public Works
- 13. Kenmore Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District
- 14. Sweet Home Central School
- 15. Brighton Volunteer Fire Company #5

As outlined in the letter from GHD undated for March 2022 (attached), the Part I Full EAF was completed using the NYSDEC's EAF Mapper Application. This is a Geographic Information

System (GIS) tool specifically designed to facilitate the SEQR process by utilizing approved spatial reference information.

Subsequently, GHD recommendation was reviewed by both the Engineering Department as well as at the request of the Legal Department an attorney from Harris Beach who specializes in SEQR related items. All concur with GHD's review. Therefore, it is recommended that the Board declare the Authority as Lead Agency under SEQR and begin the coordinated review process. In addition, it is requested that the Board authorize the Executive Engineer to sign the EAF on behalf of the Authority.

Moving forward, as Lead Agency under the coordinated review process, it will be the Authority's responsibility to submit the design documents along with the EAF to the involved agencies. The agencies will have to submit comments within thirty (30) days. The Authority will review and address any comments submitted by the designated agencies. The Authority will then make a determination of significance under SEQR. This determination will render the Authority's decision relative to the environmental impact of the project.


