On August 14, 2019 the Authority advertised for bids for the above referenced contract. One bid from Ross Valve Manufacturing Co., Inc. in the amount of \$140,000.00 was received and opened on September 10, 2019.

The contract specified inspection and rehabilitation of 2 cone valves with the allowance amount of \$10,000.00. The bid price from Ross was \$65,000 per valve, with a total (including the allowance) of \$140,000.00.

The Production Department estimate was \$25,000.00 per valve for a total of \$50,000.00. This estimate was based on past repairs of 5 out of existing 7 cone valves. The repairs were done between 2013 and 2015 and the average amount per valve was \$13,100.00

Therefore, the Production Department recommends to reject the bid from Ross Valve Manufacturing Co., Inc. and proceed with cone valve repairs using the Authority forces (Maintenance Unit).
