On December 12, 2019, the Erie County Water Authority (Authority) approved a Betterment Utility Work Agreement (HC-140) with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) for the replacement of a section of existing transmission main along Route 5 in the Town of Hamburg. A copy of the HC-140 is attached hereto.

Under the terms of that agreement, the Authority financed the replacement with the work being completed by a contractor hired by the NYSDOT. The benefit of such an agreement is threefold. First, the disturbance to the public associated with the watermain replacement is incorporated into the larger road resurfacing project. Second, the responsibility for maintenance and protection of traffic associated with the work is borne by the NYSDOT and their contractor and lastly, the cost for final paving and restoration is included in the road resurfacing project and as such reflects a savings to the Authority customers. The Authority previously reimbursed the NYSDOT \$1,851,969.60 for the project.

During construction of the watermain, additional work has been identified that should be undertaken as part of the Betterment as follows:

- Reconfiguration of interconnections between the 24-inch transmission main being replaced and existing mains on Lake Avenue. This work is required to eliminate a number of valves and piping that are no longer needed.
- ➤ Replacement of an existing road crossing at Route 5 and Second Street that is currently isolated due to a leak. Currently the isolated main prevents a loop in the system potential reducing fire flows in the area. Replacement of this section of main as part of the larger project is preferable in lieu of an individual project.

Installation of a new crossing at Route 5 and Seventh Street. This crossing was contemplated to be installed under a future capital project. Incorporating this crossing into the Betterment is preferable to eliminate disturbing of recently replaced pavement and the incorporation of the restoration into the Betterment.

The Authority's design consultant, CHA, has developed sketches for each item and has estimated the additional cost at \$289,769.10 (see attached estimate). Also attached is correspondence from the NYSDOT which outlines any additional costs that are the responsibility of the Authority. Including those fees, the total amendment request is \$372,000 including inspection fees, mobilization costs and contingency.

Funds for this amendment will be transferred from Budget Unit 2590 Eng/Const Distribution Mains Item 101518 WSA -015 Waterline Replacement. Funds are available in this budget item due to the need to revise the construction staging of the project such that a portion of the work will be completed in 2022. All project funding was originally budgeted for expenditure in 2021. Project staging has changed to account for delays in review and approval of the work by the Norfolk and Southern and South Buffalo Railroad and National Grid.

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is undertaking a transportation project described as 1.5" Mill and Resurfacing – NY 5 (SH 5019, SH 5071, SH 5407, Fac 49.10, Fac 50-2), Lake Shore Road/Hamburg Turnpike; Big Tree Road to Kane Street, City of Lackawanna, Town of Hamburg, Erie County, PIN 5813.63 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Erie County Water Authority (Authority) has developed and/or concurred with the design of upgrading an existing waterline located within the boundaries of Route NY 5, (Lake Shore Road and Hamburg Turnpike) and the plans and specifications have been prepared and are hereby referred to as municipal work; and

RESOLVED: The Authority will also deposit with the State Comptroller in a project escrow account the full amount of the contract bid price for the cost of the betterment (less any amounts already deposited for purposes thereof) for payments by the Comptroller on account of Project costs within ten days after the lowest-bidder or best-value proposer eligible for award has been identified; and be it further

RESOLVED: In the event the cost exceeds the amount of the deposit the Authority shall within 90 days of the receipt of notice from the Commissioner pay the amount of such deficiency to the State Comptroller; and any excess of the deposit shall be paid to the Authority on the warrant of the State Comptroller on vouchers approved by the Commissioner after project close out; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the Authority hereby authorizes the Chairman to enter into an agreement with the State of New York and through the Commissioner of Transportation to commit the Authority to maintain at its own expense the betterment on the above-referenced project; and that such agreement provides that maintenance shall include the repair and replacement of equipments and the operation of such betterment; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Chairman has the authority to sign, with the concurrence of the Authority, any and all documentation that may become necessary as a result of this project as it relates to the Authority; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Secretary to the Authority is hereby directed to transmit five certified copies of the foregoing resolution to Ronald Rolling, Regional Utility Engineer, New York State Department of Transportation, 100 Seneca Street, Buffalo, New York, 14203.
