On Tuesday, January 26, 2021, the Authority received three (3) bids for furnishing booster pumps and motors for the Hamburg, Lakeview, and Eden #2 Pump Stations. The bid format was specifically developed to allow the Authority to award the best fit pump for each pump station separately. Pump dimensions are important because the pumps will replace existing pumps within the pump stations. The existing pumps currently fit within a particular footprint and the suction/discharge piping diameter of each pump differ between pumps. The bids have been reviewed, a mathematical check has been performed, and an evaluation of each pump has been completed.

The pump selections for the Hamburg and Lakeview Pump Stations were awarded to Fluid Kinetics, Inc. (lowest responsive bidder) during the April 29, 2021 Board Meeting. The pump selection for the Eden #2 Pump Station were included on the April 29th Board Meeting to be awarded to Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. (lowest responsive bidder), but because ECWA did not receive the required insurance information prior to the Board Meeting, this item (No. 7) was pulled from the meeting. After the Board Meeting, ECWA received the required insurance from Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. and we would now like to award the Eden #2 Pump Station pumps to Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc.

The following is a summary of the recommended pump selections for the Eden #2 Pump Station.

Eden #2 Pump Station

Lowest Responsible, Responsive Bidder – Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc.

- Cummins-Wagner-Siewert, LLC proposed a pump, at a lower cost, but the proposed
 manufacturer is not one of the three named manufacturers listed in the contract
 documents. The pumps proposed by this vendor would not fit in the existing footprint at
 the pump station, would require modifications to the pump station piping, and could
 require modifications to the pumps' existing concrete pads. These modifications would
 increase costs and labor to install the proposed pumps.
- Fluid Kinetics, Inc. did not propose a pump for this pump station.
- Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. was the second lowest bidder, but the pump manufacturer and model are an exact replacement (replacement in-kind) of the existing pumps at each pump station. Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. was the only bidder to provide a responsive bid to this bid item.

The WMBE and apprenticeship requirements are not applicable for this contract because this is a material supply contract rather than a construction contract. The above-mentioned supplier has provided adequate proof of insurance, approved by the Authority's Claims Representative/Risk Manager.

May 3, 2021

We, therefore, recommend award of the Eden #2 Pump Station pumps to Pioneer Pump Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$64,790.00.
