The Erie County Water Authority (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

BALL PUMP STATION PHASE I REHABILITATION

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Service Center Front Desk, Erie County Water Authority** located at 3030 Union Road, Cheektowaga, New York, 14227, until **January 20, 2026 at 11:00 AM** local time. At that time, the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. When permitted, members of the public may be present to observe the bid opening. All attendees must bring a government issued photo identification (driver's license preferred) and check in with the ECWA receptionist before being allowed entry to the bid opening.

Whenever the Erie County Water Authority is operating under a Declaration of Emergency due to a pandemic or other general state of emergency, members of the public may be precluded from being present at such bid opening.

ANYONE ENTERING THE SERVICE CENTER OR OTHER AUTHORITY FACILITIES IS SUBJECT TO SUCH RESTRICTIONS OR LIMITATIONS IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.

The Project includes the following Work:

Demolition and replacement of three horizontal split case pumps and installation of one additional horizontal split case pump, including all associated valves, piping, and appurtenances. The project also includes installation of a new room within the pump station to house new VFDs, demolition and replacement of the HVAC system within the pump station, demolition and replacement of large diameter yard piping, valves, and appurtenances, and modifications to the sanitary sewerage system. All supporting civil, structural, plumbing, electrical, and instrumentation work is also included in the project.

By submission of the non-refundable payment, bidder will be registered as an official plan holder. Only official plan holders are eligible to bid on the project. Subcontractors, suppliers, equipment vendors, etc., will also be required to submit the nonrefundable payment in order to receive the Contract Documents.

Bidders acknowledge that they are responsible for review of all components of the Contract Documents, including all specification sections and drawings, regardless of how many drawings that print and in what format/size they are printed.

Pre-Bid Conference

A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **December 16, 2025 at 10:00 AM** at the Richard F. Ball Pump Station, located along Sweet Home Road adjacent to the SUNY at Buffalo North Campus (1193 Sweet Home Road, Amherst, New York 14228). Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged but not required.

Statutory Requirements


