

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The Erie County Water Authority will receive separate, sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor, plant, tools, equipment and specified materials, etc. to **Furnish and Deliver 8 Booster Pumps and Motors (Base Bid) for Erie County Water Authority Pump Stations, with an option for additional 2 Booster Pumps and Motors (Bid Alternates).**

Bids will be received by the Erie County Water Authority until 11:00 a.m. prevailing time, on Tuesday, July 9, 2019 at the Cashier's Office of the Authority, 295 Main Street, Room 350, Buffalo, New York 14203, and then at that time and place will be publicly opened and read.

All bids being mailed (including FedEx, UPS, Priority Mail, etc.) or hand-delivered to the Erie County Water Authority shall be directed to the "CASHIER'S OFFICE" at the address listed above in a sealed envelope and be clearly marked on the outside of the mailing or hand-delivered envelope "BID ENCLOSED-ECWA **Furnish and Deliver 8 Booster Pumps and Motors (Base Bid) for Erie County Water Authority Pump Stations, with an option for additional 2 Booster Pumps and Motors (Bid Alternates)**". Failure to follow the above instructions could result in rejection of the bid.

Beginning at 9:00 a.m., on Monday, June 17, 2019, the Instruction to Bidders, Form of Bid and form of Contract, Specifications, and Security Bonds may be examined at the above address and may be obtained by writing the Cashier's Office at the above address or calling (716) 849-8484, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

In accordance with State Finance Law §§139-j and 139-k, all questions about meaning or intent of the bidding documents shall be submitted to the designated contact person in writing.
